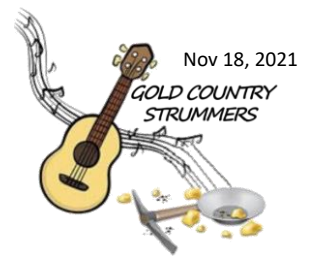

*I'll take your hat, your hair looks*

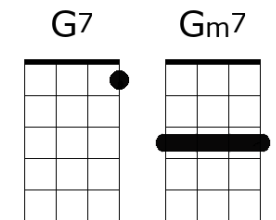
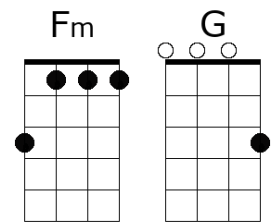
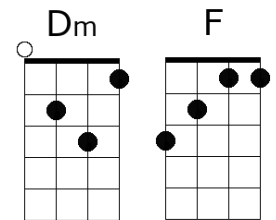
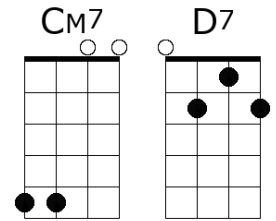
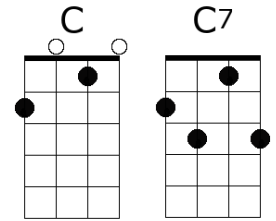
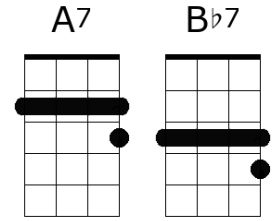
