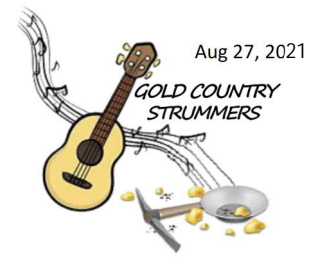


# Desperado

Now, it seems to me some fine things have been laid upon your table <sup>Em Bm C G</sup>

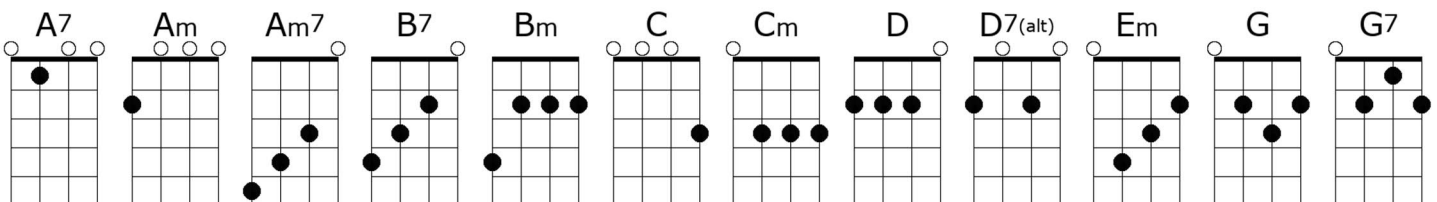
But you only want the ones that you can't get <sup>Em A7 Am7 D7</sup>

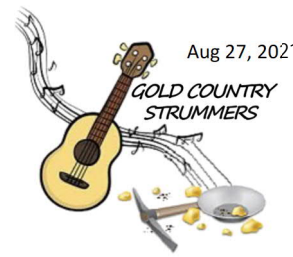
Despe-rado, <sup>G G7 C Cm</sup> oh, you ain't gettin' no younger
