

The diagrams show the following chord structures:

- A7**: Open strings on A, D, and G; fret 2 on E and C.
- A#**: Fret 2 on A, D, and G; fret 1 on E and C.
- C**: Open strings on C, E, and G; fret 2 on A and D.
- D7(alt)**: Fret 2 on A, D, and G; fret 1 on E and C.
- F**: Fret 1 on A, D, and G; fret 2 on E and C.
- G**: Fret 2 on A, D, and G; fret 3 on E and C.
