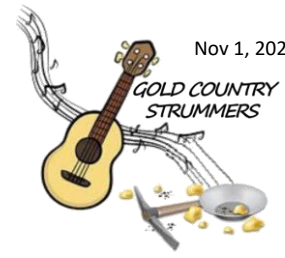

Bb7 Now we live, and work, and play **Eb** in that spot close to heaven's door

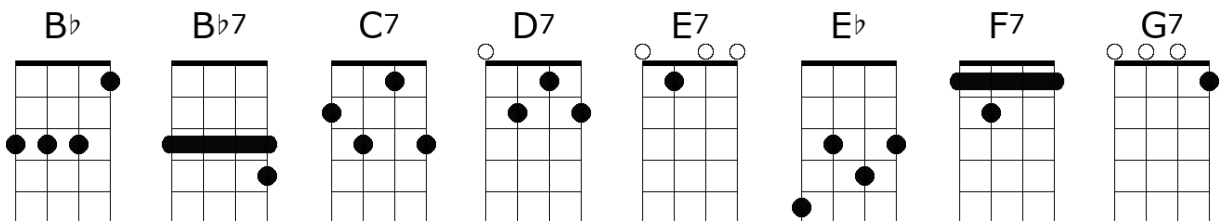
