The captain called all hands and swore he'd take that whale in tow (huh!)

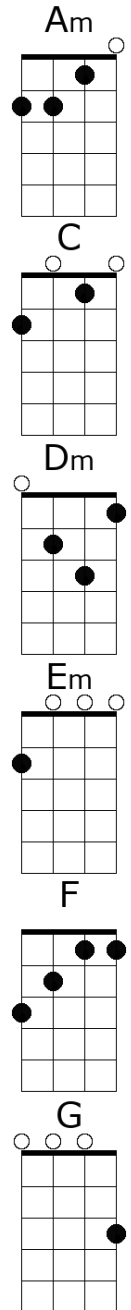
