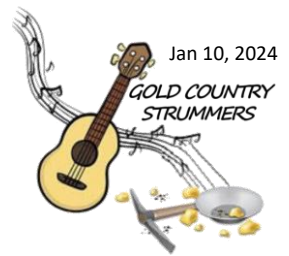


# When I'm Getting Old
